UPDATE: UGANDA DAYS FOR GIRLS PROJECT

Lion Kathy Oberlin had the following to share as an update to the "Days for Girls Project":

I wanted to send some pictures that I received from my Ugandan contact re: the funding our Lions Club sent to his community to support the Days for Girls project. Thought you might want to use for the newsletter. This funding provided for:

- education about women's hygiene
- training and supplies (fabric and materials, sewing machines) to make their own feminine hygiene products
- support for the representatives from Days for Girls to teach and train 75 women/girls in their community
- lunch, facility and transportation for the attendees

This was a great success and has led to a business for the women of this community! The sewing machines were used immediately to make the hygiene products. The women soon found out they needed to buy more fabric but had no funding, so they put their talents to work and started a store to sell baskets woven by hand, clothing they sewed with the machines, knitting, bee keeping for organic honey.

I am so impressed with their ingenuity and creativity! They are extremely grateful for our generosity and pray for blessing for all of us.
