PROJECTED 2026 INCOME TAX BRACKETS FOR MARRIED COUPLES FILING JOINTLY

Taxable Income Bracket	Tax Rate
Up to \$23,905	10%
\$23,906 - \$97,286	15%
\$97,287 - \$196,238	25%
\$196,239 - \$299,099	28%
\$299,100 - \$534,110	33%
\$534,111 - \$603,326	35%
Over \$603,327	39.6%

Property Taxes

- Proposal A has “capped” property taxes at the lesser of inflation or 5% since 1994.
- Transfers “uncap” or reset the taxable value to 50% of the SEV.
- Exemptions created to keep it capped:
 - mother, father, brother, sister, son, daughter, adopted son, adopted daughter, grandson or granddaughter (and in-laws of the same ilk).
 - Care needs to be taken – State provides 73 pages of “guidelines.”
